## Our services

Available around the clock, seven days a week, every day of the year. Services can be provided for as little as one hour through to 24 hour care on a short or long term basis.

<b>Home care</b>	Help with tasks around the house including meal preparation, washing, ironing and cleaning.
<b>Personal care</b>	Assistance with daily care activities including showering, dressing, grooming and supervision of medication.
<b>Home nursing</b>	Nursing support and care including wound care, catheter and bowel care, medication management, diabetes management, palliative care and other nursing needs.
<b>Shopping and transport</b>	Escorted trips to the shops, bank, medical and other appointments.
<b>Socialising and companionship</b>	Friends, companionship and social outings are important to quality of life. We offer support so you can continue to live an active social life inside and outside your home.
<b>Overnight care</b>	We offer active (our carer is awake most of the night) and inactive overnight care.
<b>Respite care</b>	Support for your family or primary carer who may need additional assistance or simply enjoy a short break.
<b>24 hour live-in care</b>	We offer short and long term live-in care, designed by you and your family to suit your needs.
